

## Transportation Expectations

This transportation service is a privilege, and students will be expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with expected classroom behavior. Student responsibilities are:

- Masks may be required.
- Must sit in assigned seats.
- Siblings will be seated together on the bus.
- Treat all students and driver with respect.
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself and inside the bus.
- No teasing, harassment, bullying or fighting.
- Talk only with seat partner and in a quiet voice, using appropriate language.
- Remain seated and facing forward in designated seat.
- No food, drinks, or illegal substances on the bus.
- Use seat belts when required.

Bus drivers will report all infractions to school principals, who will administer the discipline consequences. The consequences for not following any of these behavior rules will generally be followed. However, administrators do have the option of applying more severe consequences whenever merited.

- Elementary: 1st-Warning; 2nd-loss of privilege to ride for 5 school days; 3rd-loss of privilege to ride for 20 school days; 4th-loss of privilege to ride for 90 school days
- Middle School: 1st-Warning; 2nd-loss of privilege to ride for 90 school days
